► Aeronautics Days 2006 in brief

The Fifth Community Aeronautics Days is the premier event for European research and technology in aeronautics and air transport. Organised by the European Commission and the Austrian Presidency of the European Union, its theme is 'Sustainable solutions for new horizons'.

► Aeronautics Days invites the participation of all stakeholders

Aeronautics Days will bring together stakeholders from all over Europe, including Russia and the Ukraine, and from the Americas and Asia, to network, present results and discuss common future R&D projects.

► The objective

Aeronautics Days 2006 will provide a major, global forum for information exchange and dissemination of EU-funded RTD results, fostering international and cross-sectoral networking and encouraging the clustering of European research and development capacity around a shared Strategic Research Agenda (SRA).

► Themes

Parallel thematic sessions will cover a variety of key research topics, corresponding to the priorities of the EU's Framework Programme and the SRA, including:

- The 'greening' of air transport;
- Improving cost efficiency;
- Ensuring customer satisfaction;
- Safety and security;
- Increasing time efficiency;
- Air transport of the future;
- Opportunities in the Seventh Framework Programme.
